INTRO BY THE KEEPER OF THE LOG

The 79th CREW Reunion will be in Greensboro, NC at the Embassy Suites Greensboro Airport. The SS Fellowship will dock on June 19, 2016. The CREW Hospitality Room will be open for drinks and hors d'oeuvres during selected times of the day. As you can see from our registration form, you are on your own for all meals except for breakfast and the evening happy hour which are included with your hotel stay. Greensboro began around 1740 when Quakers moved into the area. The Revolutionary battle was led by American General Nathanael Green at the Battle of Guilford Courthouse on March 15, 1781 which led to Lord Cornwallis's defeat at Yorktown 7 months later. In 1807 local residents elected officials, purchased a 42-acre tract of land for \$98, and named it "Greensborough", later to be changed to Greensboro, in honor of Major General Greene who won the Battle of Guilford Courthouse. In 1837, the Quakers of the New Garden Community formed a boarding school that is known today as Guilford College, the first coeducational Institution in the South. This is where I went to College as well as Mate Jim Morgan who will be returning this year in April for our 50th Graduation Reunion. I grew up just South of here in Liberty, NC on a 500 acre farm and my Father was Clerk of the Liberty Friends Meeting (a Quaker Church). Yes, I am a birthright Quaker, just as Mate Richard M. Nixon was. During the Civil War, Greensboro was a railroad center for the Confederacy supplying Robert E. Lee's Army of Northern Virginia. Greensboro became the seat of the Confederacy on April 11, 1865 as Confederate President Jefferson Davis arrived here after Lee's surrender at Appomattox. FYI, both Robert E. Lee and Jefferson Davis were relatives of our late Mate Jeff Davis from GA. Just South of Greensboro is Level Cross, home of Legendary Race Car Drivers, Lee and Richard Petty. Our theme this Year is "**Reunion of Anniversary Years leading to our 100 Years in 2020.**" Mate John Sprole is my 2nd Mate in Charge of CREW Reunions. Nomination to the Keeper of the LOG: name of nominee, address, phone nos, email, spouse, etc. Give a brief summary of Jaycee Career (note: ones credentials for consideration for admission to the CREW of the SS Fellowship are based primarily on one's Jaycee Career and very little to do with ones JCI Senate Career) and dates including National, State, and Local Chapter Offices held, awards, etc. Post Jaycee Career including JCI Senate, Jaycee Foundations and Alumni Groups such as Corps, etc. Name of Nominator, Signature of Nominator and Date signed by the nominator. The CREW nominator should make a check payable to "The CREW of the SS Fellowship" (for an amount of \$100 or more but may consider less), which accompanies the nomination of a new Mate to the CREW. This has been customary since the inception of The CREW of the SS Fellowship. NOTE: Remember one cannot buy ones way into the CREW of the SS Fellowship and must be nominated by a current Mate. The accompanying check must be from the nominator, not the nominee.
